

Members,

The LLIC Board of Directors has discussed the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and how it would affect our operations this year. We have crafted this document to put forth some updated policies in response to the virus and this policy will remain in effect until modified or rescinded. This is a living document and may be updated from time to time.

We believe in our membership and their ability to be smart and responsible. We do not want to overregulate our membership, but there are some policies we feel that we must put forth to protect everyone and the LLIC and to remain compliant with Executive Order No. 143.

Beach - The beach will be open for usage by members, with the following modifications:

- 1) You are strongly encouraged to wear a face covering while at the beach.
- 2) Beach parties up to 50 people at one time will be allowed.
- 3) Families who choose to use the beach must remain socially distant from each other. Be mindful and do not encroach upon or get too close to other families.
- 4) Guests or non-members may visit the beach, subject to standard requirements. E.g. members must be present, tags are required, etc.
- 5) Pursuant to Executive Order 143, the playground will be closed and not to be used.
- 6) Above all, we ask that beachgoers be respectful of social distancing. While you may not feel it is important, this is a requirement of the executive order.

Lake and Property -

The LLIC is not placing any restrictions on the usage of the lake. You may do anything normally allowed by rules, so long as you are not violating any state law, county regulation, or executive order. Again, all we ask is that when you are coming into proximity to other people, please be respectful and practice social distancing.

Clubhouse - The clubhouse is closed for rentals until further notice.

Golf - Lake Lackawanna Golf Club has been open for business since May 2nd.

The LLIC thanks you for your understanding during these interesting times. All we are really asking is for members to use common sense and make smart decisions, and to not put anyone else in jeopardy. We understand summer is coming and people want to use the beach, and fortunately executive order 143 allows us to do so with some limitations.
